ENTRIES FOR HORSE RING EVENTS:

A REGISTRATION FEE of \$10 applies to each HORSE. You will be issued with a number which will entitle that horse to enter any events on the day in Rings 1, 2 & 3.

ASH Time Trial Entry fee \$5 per horse. On placing in an event, please ensure you have your entry number close by to show the steward for recording.

SHOW.JUMPING ENTRIES to be made at Showjumping Section. Events 1 & 2 \$5; Events 3, 4, 5 & 6 \$6.

INDEMNITY FORMS

Indemnity forms to be signed at the Ring Secretary's Office before entering any event. Competitors will then be issued with a wrist band.

DISPUTES

The decision of the judge will be final unless a protest is lodged at the Ring Secretary's Office in writing within thirty minutes accompanied by a deposit of \$25 which will be forfeited if the Ring Committee finds the protest frivolous and the decision of the Ring Master and two of the Ring Committee on a protest shall be final.

Exhibitors making verbal protest in the ring will risk the penalty of expulsion from future shows at the Ring Committee's pleasure.

CLASHING OF EVENTS

In the event of two classes clashing in any ring, competitor to choose which class to enter. No ring will be held up for any competitor unless the Judge decides, in his or her absolute discretion that time permits.

DEFINITIONS

LOCAL means exhibitor shall reside within 35 km of Ariah Park Post Office, measurement to be taken to the nearest point of holding upon which exhibitor resides, for six months prior to the show.

A **NOVICE HACK** is one which has not been placed first in any individual Ridden Hack class at any official show.

An **ELEMENTARY HACK** is one which has not been placed first on more than three occasions in any individual ridden hack classes at any official show.

An **INTERMEDIATE HACK** is one which has never been placed first, second or third in any individual ridden hack classes at any Royal Show including the RNA.

SHOW HUNTER CLASSES. Horses competing in Show Hunter classes may not also compete in Hack classes and vice versa. Horses may **NOT** compete in both Hunter and Hack classes.

.IMPROPER BEHAVIOUR Improper behaviour will not be permitted. Offender's names will be submitted to the ASC.

STALLIONS: All stallions/colts must be handled or ridden by a person over the age of 18 years..

AGE OF EXHIBITS: The breeding year commences on August $1^{\rm st}$ each year to determine age of horses..

REGISTERED BREED EVENTS: Papers must be made available on request **RULES FOR WELSH CLASSES AT SHOWS**

All exhibits must be registered with the WP & CS and must be shown in the name of the registered owner or lessee.

Welsh must be shown in the Section of the WP & CS Stud book in which they are registered e.g. Section A, Section B, Section C, Section D.

Part Welsh are only eligible to compete in classes especially provided for them or classes marked.

Bitting – all colts 2 years and over must be bitted in the ring.

Clipping – Exhibits 3 years and under must not be body clipped for showing. Those 4 years and over which have been clipped for winter activities can be shown. Visible body, ear or neck clipping for shows is not permissible. Trimming is permissible including the ears, throat-latch, lower jaw, jawline and muzzle. Fresh body clipping for shows is not permissible.

For Part Welsh exhibits, clipping is optional.

Plaiting – At shows where WP & CSA has no jurisdiction the rule re no plaiting cannot be enforced and plaited exhibits should not be penalised

GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

All exhibits must be bona fide property of exhibitor, or his principal, at date of entry.

- 1. The Society is not responsible for the loss of or damage to any exhibit.
- Exhibitors bringing entire horses must notify the secretary three days before the show, so that stalls may be allocated.
- No exhibitor shall be allowed with the judge during judging. The judge may refuse to judge the exhibits of any exhibitor infringing this rule.
- The interpretation of any regulations by the Ringmaster and/or the Ring Committee shall be final.
- All stewards/stewardesses shall withdraw while judging of exhibits in which they are interested, directly or indirectly, is taking place.
- 6. The Society will take all reasonable care for the safety of all exhibits, but will not be held responsible for any accident or loss that might occur to, from, or by any exhibitor during the show, and that each exhibitor should hold the management of the society blameless and indemnify it from legal proceedings arising from any such lesser accident.

The above rules and regulations are to be read in conjunction with all other rules and regulations printed in the Show Schedule.

This trophy is donated by the Heinrich Family and will be presented by Mrs Tracey Heinrich, daughter of the late Honor Howard who was a great admirer of the Australian Stock Horse, also bred them in the 1970s and Tracey and David's Boganvilla ASH Stud can still trace their ancestry back to these early beginnings. Honor was a ring steward at the Ariah Park Show for many years and a valued member of the community.

The horse and rider combination accruing the highest number of points from classes 1-27 (with the exception of youth under 18 classes) shall be the winner. Horses eligible to compete in Maiden classes may also compete in Open classes; however points may only be awarded in either Maiden OR Open classes NOT both.

First: 3 points; Second 2 points; Third 1 point.

Points will not be awarded for Champions, Reserve Champions or Supreme Champions. Riders under the age of 18 are unable to compete for this award. In the event of two or more horses obtaining the same number of points, the judge shall specify a workout for such horses, and the judge's decision on the winner shall be final.
