GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

- The Ringmaster & Committee reserves the right to alter, delete or combine, without notice, any event on the program.
- Hack and Breed Entry on the day.
- Showjumping Entry via Global Entries Online by Tuesday 27th September 2016 by 5pm.
- Entry Tickets are to be purchased from the Horse Ticket Office on the day of the Show. Pre-purchase available prior to 16th September.
- ENTRY TICKETS ARE NOT REFUNDABLE
- The Committee reserves the right to substitute a judge, without notice.
- THE JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL.
- Disputes MUST be made in writing and lodged with a deposit of \$20.00 within one (1) hour of the event. Deposits will be refunded if the dispute is found in favour of the lodging party.
- ALL RIDERS MUST COMPETE IN EA APPROVED HEADWEAR
- ALL EXHIBITORS', RIDERS, DRIVERS, HANDLERS, ETC. MUST SIGN WAIVERS AND WEAR WRISTBANDS.
- All competitors must be suitably attired and must conduct themselves in an orderly manner at all times.
- Only Competitors actually taking part in an event will be allowed in the ring.
- The start of an event will not be delayed for a competitor taking part in another event.
- A Novice is an exhibit who/that has not won a first at a recognized Show.
- All stallions & colts are to be handled by a person 18 years and over at all times.
- Stallions are Not Eligible to compete in Open Hack or all Hunter Classes unless specified.
- All Breed classes must be registered with the relevant Society and be current financial members. Papers WILL be checked at random. Failure to comply will incur disqualification and loss of awards and prizes.
- A Child Rider is a Rider under 17 years. Adult Rider is a Rider 17 years and over.
- Off The Track – The event is open to all Thoroughbreds that have officially raced or trialed either locally, nationally or internationally. All horses are required to be 3 years and over and 14.2hh and over. *All horses will be Registered with Racing Australia. Registrations will be checked.* Racing name to be used. Horse & Owner must reside in ACT or NSW to compete in Off The Track ACT/NSW Series.
- Hacks and Show Hunters to compete only in their respective classes.
(Hacks not to compete in Show Hunters Classes, Show Hunters not to compete in Hacks Classes - *with exception of Ridden Classes e.g. Child, Adult and Pleasure Classes*)
- Prizes shall be Ribbons.
- Champion & Reserve Champion Awards will be made at the discretion of the Judge. The Champion will be selected from the First Place winners from each of the eligible classes. The Reserve Champion following the selection of Champion, will be selected from the remaining 1st Prize winners and 2nd Prize winner from the class which supplied the Champion.

NEWCOMER DEFINITION

- For horses that have never competed under saddle in any discipline or competition, (excluding Racing Events) official or unofficial anywhere, prior to a date determined by each State/Territory in which the horse resides and is registered.
- A Pony that has only competed in Leading Rein or Miniature Turnouts and has not competed off the lead is eligible to be considered a Newcomer.
- A horse that has competed in breed classes under saddle is NOT eligible to be considered a Newcomer. Competing in ridden breed classes prior to the qualifying period will render a horse or pony ineligible to compete as a newcomer.
- The Horse must be shown in a snaffle bridle.
- Stallions are NOT eligible to compete in Newcomer classes.
- The onus is on the owner to ensure they meet the conditions of entry as stated.
- The Bathurst AH&P Association Newcomer competition dates are from 1/1/16 through to 31/12/16.

STABLING- Large horses will have priority over large stables & yards and heavy horses will have priority over heavy horse yards.

Those who need stallion boxes for the day **MUST** book them as per any other exhibitor.

Stables are booked on a 24 hour basis 5pm to 5pm.

Stables/yards must be vacated by 5pm on the day of departure if not booked for that day. Bedding will not be provided.

All stables to be cleaned and all bedding removed by departure time. Failure to comply will result in the \$30 cleaning deposit being forfeited to the Association.

Refunds – Stabling fees will not be refunded if the stabling is cancelled.

- **ENTRIES**
 - Enter online at: globalentriesonline.com.au
 - Entries will open Friday 5th August 2016.
 - Entries close at 5pm Tuesday 27th September 2016.
 - Change of Classes after closing date/time and late entries may incur a surcharge.
 - No entries will be accepted unless accompanied by the correct entry fee, camping/stabling fee, stable/yard bond and EA numbers (where required).
 - Limit of 3 entries per horse per day. The Association wishes to remind competitors and horse owners that the Exhibit's (horse) welfare must be considered above all else when making entry decisions.
 - Refund of entries will be given for scratching made before 5.00pm Tuesday 27th September 2016. Thereafter, a veterinary or doctors certificate must be produced to claim a refund. Any refund after the scratching deadline is at the discretion of Bathurst AH&PA.
- **RULES**
 - The Bathurst AH&P Association General Rules, General Regulations & the Spring Show Supplementary Regulations shall apply.
 - THE FEI Rules for Jumping and EA Addendum to the Rules will apply.
 - All horses must be registered with the EA to enter & compete in **Official** classes.

- All riders must be currently registered with the EA to enter & compete in **Official** classes.
 - Riders & horses in **Unofficial** classes are encouraged to be members of the EA, the Bathurst AH&P Association or any other EA affiliated club.
 - Australian helmet standards will apply. All riders must wear approved boots and helmet whilst mounted, including presentations, training, before and after the event.
 - **Dogs are not encouraged at the event.** All dogs must be tied up or on leads and secured at all times. No dogs are allowed on to the competition arena or practice arenas at any time.
 - Exhibitors & owners are reminded that the safety & control of their horses & livestock are completely their own responsibility for their safety or any damage they may cause.
 - Horses & livestock should not be left unattended, tethered to floats, trucks or structures in the Showground without appropriate care and control being exercised over them.
 - All riders competing at this event will be expected to have read these rules and conditions and to have completed a waiver form before competition commences.
 - It is a requirement of competition at Bathurst AH&PA equestrian events for the owner/rider/exhibitor to warrant that any exhibit (horse) attending in their care is fit and healthy.
- **NO ABUSE OF OFFICIALS OR VOLUNTEERS WILL BE TOLERATED.** Failure to follow instruction from the Show Secretary, Stewards or other Officials will result in disqualification from the event.
 - The Bathurst AH&PA reserves the right to amend any part of the program at their discretion.

- **PRIZES & PRESENTATIONS—SHOWJUMPING**
 - All classes will be awarded ribbons to 5th place. Nominated classes carry cash prizes; other classes may receive product prizes at the discretion of the committee.
 - Cash prize winners will receive vouchers which are redeemable for prize money at the Horse Office after all outstanding fees and requirements are settled. (Prize money for Official classes will require presentation of signed EA Performance Cards.)
 - All prize presentations are to be conducted in the presentation area in front of the Grandstand at the completion of each class unless otherwise announced. Recipients will be required to be mounted and appropriately attired to receive their prize. Height Champion Trophy Rugs will be presented at the completion of all classes on the last day for the specified classes.
- **SAFETY & RISK MANAGEMENT**
 - The Bathurst AH&PA shall address and act upon all safety issues at the event. We would request your attention to safety at all times and ask for your cooperation with the ground staff.
 - The Agricultural Societies Council of NSW & Bathurst AH&P Association advises that the participation, including passive participation, in events or activities at an agricultural show contains elements of risk, both obvious and inherent. The risks involved may result in property damage and/or personal injury including death.

- **CAMPING**
 - Camping is available on site from Friday 30th September – Monday 3rd October 2016 inclusive. The minimum camping fee is \$22 per vehicle/float per night. Larger vehicles or more than 2 people per site may incur an additional levy at the discretion of the organiser.
 - Onsite showers & toilets available. Power is accessible to most sites with your own leads. Proper safety must be used by campers in accessing power.
 - **NO FIRES ON GRASS AREAS.** Anyone wishing to have a fire must have it approved by the Show Secretary prior to use.
 - **To ensure your booking, camping must be reserved and paid for at the time of entry by 5pm Tuesday 27th September 2016.**
- **STABLING & YARDS**
 - **There is a limited supply of Open Yards reserved for Showjumpers it is recommended you book these as soon as possible by 5pm Tuesday 27th September 2016.**
 - A variety of stabling and a specific set of Open Yards are available on site from Friday 30th September – Monday 3rd October 2016 inclusive. The minimum fee for an open yard is \$12 per night and \$18.00 per night for stabling.
 - A refundable Stable/Yard Cleaning fee of \$30 per Stable/Yard is payable at the time of booking.
 - The use of temporary fencing of any kind is not allowed.
 - **To ensure your booking, stabling must be reserved and paid for at the time of entry. YARD/STABLING FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRIES.**

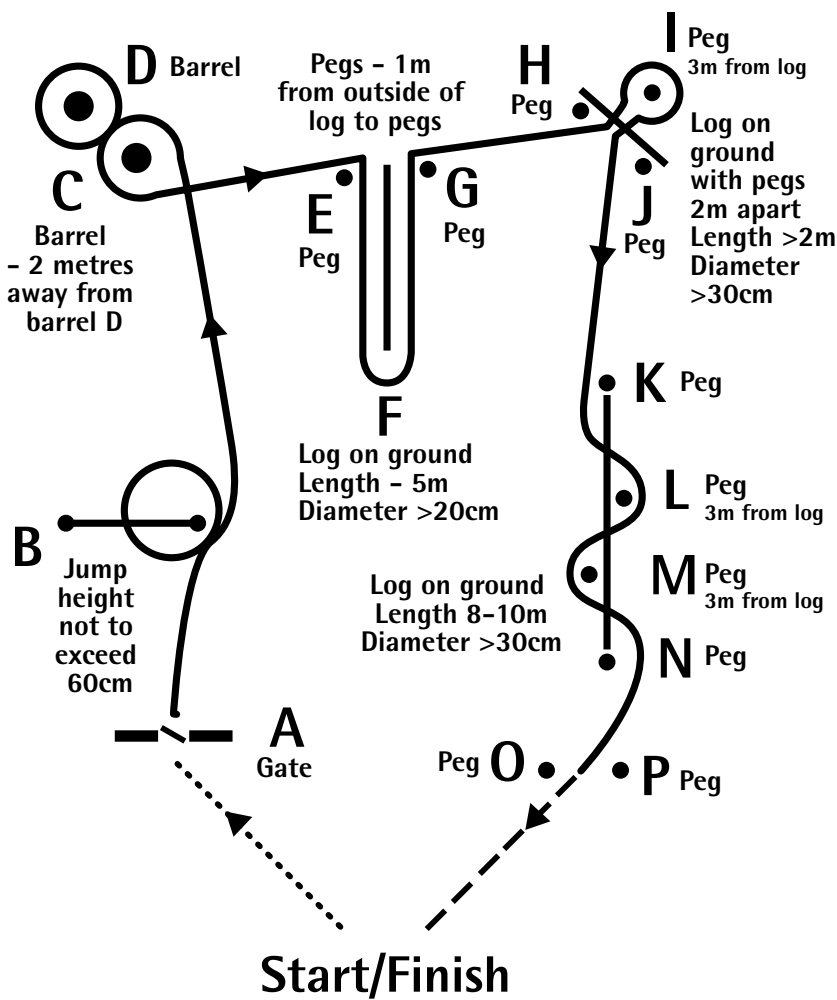

Course

1. Commence course between the start/finish pegs at a Walk. Walk to gate at A. Once the rider's hand touches the gate, the horse may continue the course at any pace to O & P pegs
2. Open the gate, pass through and close the gate – the gate latch must be securely fastened
3. Continue past the jump at B, leaving the jump on the near side of the horse. Turn and jump the jump, continue to circle around the end of the jump to the barrel at C
4. Leave barrel C on the near side of the horse, circle anti-clockwise half a circle around barrel C, circle barrel D clockwise a full circle and then circle C anti-clockwise half a circle to complete figure of eight (Note: two meter distance between the edges of Barrel C and D). Continue to Peg E
5. Leave the peg E on the off side of the horse, complete a 90° turn to the right and continue along the length of log F
6. At the end of log F, turn 180° around the end of the log and continue along the other side of log F towards Peg G. Leaving Peg G on the off side of the horse, turn 90° and continue towards log between Pegs H & J
7. At Peg H, jump the log between the pegs, then around peg I on the off side of the horse and jump back over log at J and continue towards Peg K
8. Jump log between pegs K and N three (3) times in a serpentine

motion, starting with peg K on left and going around pegs L and M with final jump having peg N on right. Come back to trot between O and P

9. Continue to O, reducing the pace of the horse to a Trot prior to crossing a line between the Pegs O and P. (Note: 1 meter distance between the O and P pegs).
10. Then continue at a Trot to start/finish pegs. Horse must Trot between the start/finish pegs to complete the course.

Rules

1. The time commences and terminates when the horse's nose crosses the line between the start/finish pegs
2. A one (1) second penalty will be incurred for each stride that is broken in the Walk and Trot sections
3. A three (3) second penalty will be incurred if the Gate, Jumps, Barrels at C & D; the logs at F, H or K or any peg from E through P is dislodged
4. When jumping the log at H and K, the horse's four feet must touch the ground on the other side of the obstacle before returning over the log. Failure to do so will result in elimination.
5. A horse will be eliminated for not completely and correctly negotiating any section of the course
6. Head restraints are not permitted
7. The Walk section must be a four beat pace Walk.
8. A one (1) second penalty will be incurred for each hoof which crosses the log at F.
9. Penalties will be added to the time and the time will become the score for this section.
10. The horse with the lowest score will be determined as the winner.

Safety

1. For safety, if logs of less than the designated diameters are not available, the logs MUST be securely pinned to the ground in order to prevent all movement.

Notes

In their age group under 13 years of age must open the gate but do not have to close it.

Horse Handling Participant Risk Acknowledgement & Waiver

 - 1.2. participation in animal handling is a hazardous activity and may result in injury, loss, damage or death to me;
 - 1.3. participation in animal handling requires certain skills and experience. I declare that I have sufficient skills and experience to be able to safely and properly participate in the events;
 - 1.4. animals can act in a sudden and unpredictable ways, especially if frightened or hurt, or if exposed to loud or unfamiliar noises;
 - 1.5. animal showing events will be held in close proximity to rides and large groups of people, and that there may be loud and unfamiliar noises which can frighten animals;
 - 1.6. if the event is held outdoors, there are risks to me as a result of the weather conditions, including either extreme hot or cold weather, rain or wind;
