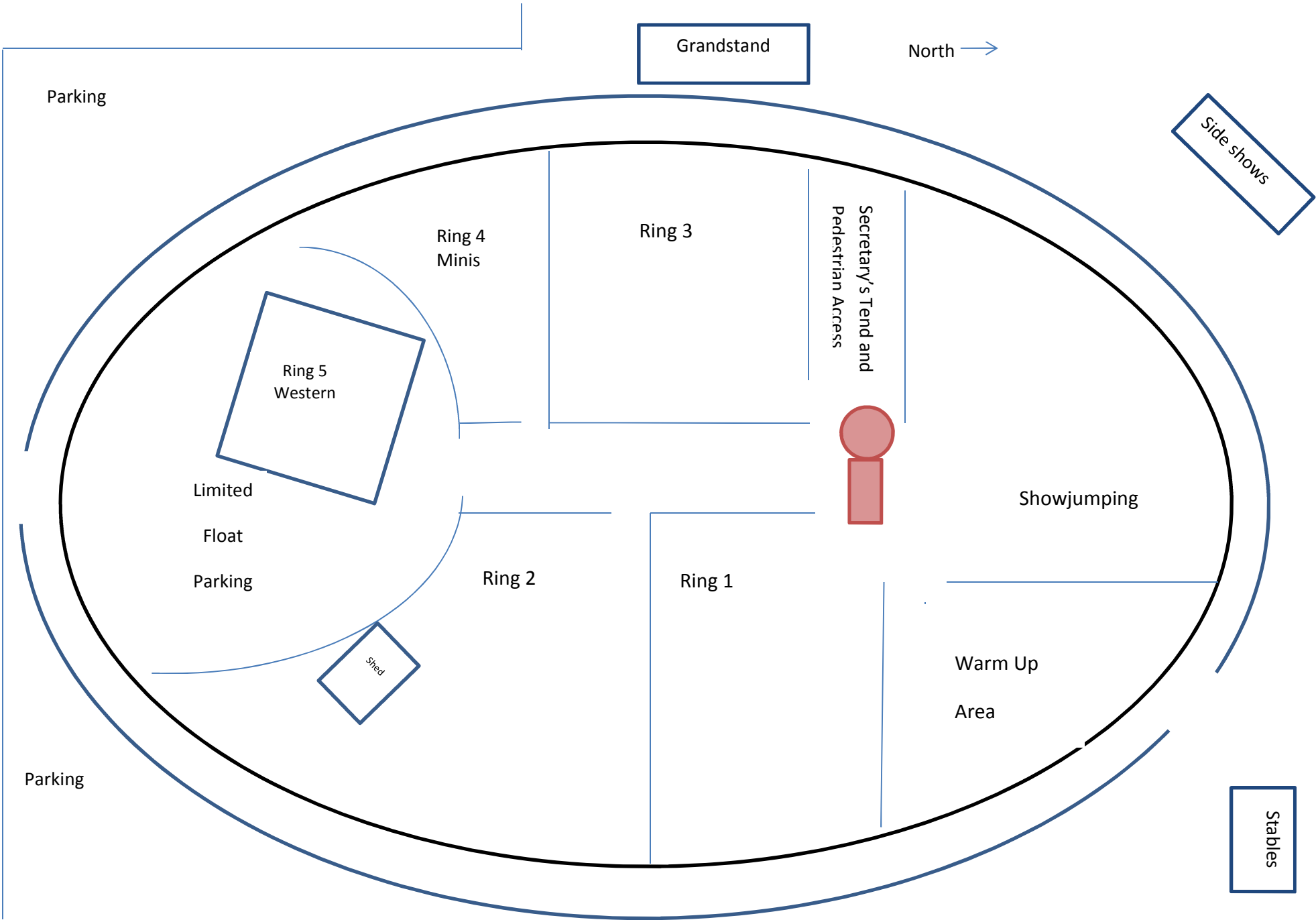

### Conditions

- **Please DO NOT PARK on the trotting track as it will be used during the day for the “Go to Town” trots event.**
- Ring event tickets may be purchased from the Ring Office for \$2 each. Ticket required upon entry into ring. Showjumping entries are taken at Ring Office, tickets not required, however wristbands are.
- All riders and handlers must sign an indemnity form before they enter, including horse identification details **complete with PIC numbers**. Wristbands will be issued to competitors upon completion of Indemnity Form. No wristband, no competing.
- The show will be run under ASC rules.
- **Drug testing may be carried out at this Show.** Any competitor, exhibitor, owner found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary Regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee and dealt with accordingly.
- Schedule status – this schedule may be subject to change if judges or sponsorships cannot be obtained. The Committee reserves the right to amend the schedule. Lunch breaks will be held at Judges discretion.
- Rings will be stopped while the “Go to Town” trots event takes place
- Prizemoney – Ridden classes 1<sup>st</sup> \$3, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$2 and ribbons. Led classes receive ribbons only.
- Hack and Hunter classes - Competitors must choose between Open classes and Hunter classes. They may not compete in both.
- Adult and Child classes – Competitors must choose between adult and child hack classes. An exhibit may not compete in both.
- Novice – Open to competitors/exhibits who have not won a first prize at an agricultural show
- Local Rider - is a rider who is a resident of the Weddin Shire.
- Local Hack – is a hack who is kept within the Weddin Shire.
- Age of exhibits – The age as at August 1<sup>st</sup> each year determines the age of the exhibit
- Registered breed events – Papers must be made available for presentation upon request
- Stallions – All stallions/colts must be handled or ridden by a person over 18 years, and only eligible to compete in allotted classes, with exception of Western Ring. No Stallions will be housed on Showground overnight.
- Measuring – must take place prior to 8.30am, enquire at Ring Office. RAS Card or Grenfell Measurements accepted.
- Disputes – The decision of the judge will be final. A protest must be lodged in writing with \$50 to the Ring Office within 30 minutes. The matter will be considered by the Ringmaster and two of the Ring Committee, and if considered to be frivolous, the decision will stand and \$50 will be forfeited.
- Ringmasters decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. We look forward to enjoying a great day of good horsemanship and sportsmanship. We hope you have a successful and enjoyable 2016 Grenfell Show.



# Show Jumping

Commences with course walk at 8.00am on Saturday, 3 September 2016. Entries taken at Ring Office from 7.30am, see below for entry fee relevant to class. Wristbands will be provided upon completion of Waiver Form. No Wristband, No Competing. No age limit to competitors, riders must be suitably attired and wear appropriate standard headwear.

**Class Five**– this is a fun event. Riders are required to jump 6-8 numbered fences, dismount and get on a carriage and be driven through 6-8 numbered obstacles. The winner is the rider taking the shortest time to complete the whole course. Five seconds are added to the competitor's time for each jump dislodged, or obstacle disturbed during the drive stage. Being a timed event, riders achieving a double clear round will not necessarily be the winner. Ellmore Driving Club will provide carriages and horse. Riders will draw for their order of attempting the course. They will then be advised of the carriage upon which they will travel for the drive part of the course. There will be a full brief for riders, drivers and officials on the conduct of the event before the walking the course.

**NOTE:** All first place competitors will receive three bales of Lucerne hay, while all second place and third place competitors will receive chaff and produce. Hay, chaff and produce is to be collected by competitors within half an hour after the completion of the last class.

## Off the Track ACT/NSW Series

1. The event is open to all thoroughbreds that have officially raced or trialed either locally, nationally or internationally. All horses are required to be 3 years and over and 14.2hh. All horses will be registered with Racing Australia.  
**\*Registrations will be checked.**
2. Racing name to be used.
3. Qualifying Shows must be affiliated with Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Ltd or Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc.
4. OTT Qualifying classes will be judged as a ridden class.
5. Once a qualifier has been won, the horse cannot compete in other qualifiers within the season. Horses that have achieved Runner Up are able to continue in the competition unless they win an OTT Qualifier class. The winner and runner up of each qualifying class will be eligible to compete in the State Final.
6. Horses will be judged as a good example of a Thoroughbred rather than riding horse/hunter types with the following being taken into consideration.
  - Thoroughbred qualities
  - Conformation
  - Manners, paces and performance
  - Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
7. Judges decision is final in qualifiers and final.
8. Horse and Owner must reside in ACT or NSW to compete in the Off the Track ACT/NSW Series.
