REGULATIONS FOR ALL HORSE COMPETITORS

- All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Rules for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows. Should it become necessary for the ASC Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section this Society will support any penalty imposed by the Committee as a result of the inquiry,
- The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the schedule to meet emerging circumstances
- The judge is empowered to withhold any or all prizes in any class where the exhibits are in his or her opinion unworthy of the prize. At all times, the judge's decision will be final. The judge has the discretion to ask that a led or performance exhibit and handler/rider/driver be ordered to leave the ring is he/she considers the animal is unruly and/or likely to cause an accident.
- If a led exhibit should drag or escape its handler or a ridden or driven horse take control or unseat its rider and leave the ring it is usually disqualified from the class.
- Competitors must be ready when called. Once judging has commenced a competing horse shall not be led, ridden or driven into or out of the ring without the permission of the judge and/or ringmaster.
- DISTRICT EVENTS are open to exhibits which <u>are owned AND ridden</u> by those resident, for at least three months prior to the show, within a 20km radius of Holbrook Showground OR those for whom Holbrook Show is there only LOCAL show.
- NOVICE: an exhibit which has not won a first prize at any show.
- INTERMEDIATE: an exhibit which has not won a 1st, 2nd, or 3rd prize at any Royal or HOTY show
- Exhibits must nominate in either SHOW HUNTER or OPEN HACK classes and compete in both rings as such.
- STALLIONS must be wearing a bit at all times when being led or ridden and must be under the control of a person 17years
 or older. They must be supervised at all times and securely fastened when tied to the outside of a truck of float. They are
 not eligible to compete in ridden classes unless specifically stated in the schedule.
- BREED REGISTRATION documents for exhibits in breed classes must be produced when required by the steward
- No official MEASURING will take place at this show but if a question about height arises proof of height may be required.
 In the absence of proof, a decision will be made at the absolute discretion of the Chief Steward.
- All riders are encouraged to wear a SAFETY HELMET compliant with the current Australian Standard. Riders under 18 years MUST wear such a helmet.
- All riders must wear appropriate FOOTWEAR when leading or riding an exhibit. When riding, the footwear must be removable from the stirrup.
- Persons who are considered by the chief steward to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the ground. No
 horse will be permitted to compete if, in the opinion of the Chief Steward, it is in poor health or condition.
- No exhibitor or associate will initiate a conversation with a judge on judging day, before or after judging, except through the chief steward.
- No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has or has recently had
 a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the previous 12 months.
- Any person detected COACHING a competitor while the competitor is being judged may be removed from the showground.
- Any person who behaves offensively on the Showground will be expelled from the ground, may be banned from the show in the future and may be banned by other societies.
- A PROTEST or complaint against any exhibit or exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the chief steward or the relevant section no later than ten minutes after the judging of the exhibit or exhibitor. The Chief Steward must be provided with the exact nature of the complaint and act if necessary to maintain competitive fairness. The Chief Steward may choose to refer the matter to the Protests Committee which shall comprise the President of the Society or a Vice President and two other members of the General Committee. A protest or complaint or an appeal against the decision of a Chief Steward may be lodged in writing with the secretary no later than 10pm on the day of judging. Such protest, compliant or appeal shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which shall be forfeited if the protest, complaint or appeal proves to be frivolous or vexatious. A matter lodged this way shall be dealt with by the Protests Committee within 24hrs of lodgement and the decision of the Protest Committee shall be final, NB No protest or complaint will be considered if it refers simply to a judge's decision.
- <u>ONLY</u> IF AN EXHIBIT WINS A <u>CHAMPION</u> IN EITHER OPEN RING IT IS NOT ELIGBLE TO COMPETE IN THE SECOND OPEN RING. OPEN RINGS ARE RINGS 2 & 3.

INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS: The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Holbrook Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for the loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Holbrook Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18years of age. ALSO on each waiver <u>each horse</u> with which the competitor is involved in competition at the Holbrook Show <u>must be</u> listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the show.
