Parking is adjacent or on the grounds. All must pay gate entry fee \$15.00 Adults - \$12.50 for Children 4-16/Students/Pensioners. All competitors must have their wrist band on prior to registration. (Saturday Only)

Property Identification Number (PIC No.) It is a NSW Livestock Regulation LAW that all competitors MUST have a Property Identification Number on their entry form. Failure to do so may incur a penalty of \$20,000 for the show society.

All people entering the Arena must have signed a Waiver form and have a competitor number (whether competing or not). The number must be displayed at all times. Competitor numbers are available from the Registration desk. During the day random competitors numbers will be called out. The winners can win spot prizes from bales of hay to nicknacks.

Failure to have a competitor number or horse number will mean that the competitor or animal is ineligible to compete and must leave the Main Arena immediately, including parking area.

Entry Fee. Hacks \$12.50 per horse, Saturday & \$18.5 Sunday per day. Show jumping, Adult Riders, Dressage and Team Yarding as per schedule. Competitors must have signed waiver - have horse and rider/handler number. Failure to complete forms will lead to disqualification.

Leeton Show Society uses standard indemnity forms and animal declaration forms. These forms can be downloaded from the ASC website or www.leetonshowsociety.org.au/forms and filled out prior to leaving for show, or follow the links on the adjacent table.

ALL RIDERS must wear approved safety helmets to the current Australian, standard, whilst competing and exercising. **NO OTHER HEAD GEAR WILL BE PERMITTED**

Any Pony, Galloway or Hack awarded a champion in ring 1 is ineligible to compete in ring 2 & 6 and vice versa

Show Hunters are ineligible to compete in open Hack events.

Improper behavior: outside assistance to competitors by word of mouth, radio or any other methods in ring events will not be permitted. Any competitor and their exhibits found to be in breaching this ruling will be dismissed from the event and the show ground and will be reported to the ASC.

Every endeavor has been made to avoid the clashes of events. **EVENTS WILL NOT BE HELD UP.** It is the responsibility of the competitor to be on time and to have made a choice of event. Competitors may not enter a class after the judging has commenced.

The committee may alter the program without notice if necessary - a minimum of three (3) competitors for a class to be split or for a class to be added or prize to be awarded.

Drug testing of animals may be carried out by the ASC.

The ringmaster decision is final notwithstanding an appeals procedure is available on payment of \$50 refundable deposit if successful. The appeal must be lodged within 30 minutes of disputation.

The judge may or may not award a placing if in their opinion the standard is of insufficient merit.

Stallions

Stallions should wear official 'discs' at all times whilst at the venue. These

No stallion is to be moved around a venue without displaying the stallion discs and a suitable restraint. The restraint can be a bridle, a rearing bit or a chain lead rein over the nose or under the jaw.

Where possible all stallions are to be stabled. If suitable stabling is not available stallions need to wear a collar, which is securely tied to the outside of a truck or trailer. Stallions tied to the outside of a truck or trailer MUST be supervised at all times.

Stallions may be substituted in prize-giving ceremonies with another horse should the rider deem it to be safer.

It is recommended that riders and handlers of stallions at shows be over the age of 18 years; however, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to understand the full code of conduct for stallions at events. With the exception of rule 1.1.8 in the Show Horse Rules and Guidelines, stallions are not permitted in Show Horse classes at EA State or Championship events. All riders/handlers under the age of 17 years must be supervised by an adult/parent/guardian whilst at the event. It is the stallion owner's/rider's responsibility to ensure that all possible safety precautions are taken.

Floats/Trucks that transport stallions should display the official magnet giving notice that there is a stallion on board.

The Horse committee reserve the right to reject any entry without fear or favour. This decision is final.

Conduct unbecoming will require the offender/s to immediately leave the grounds.
