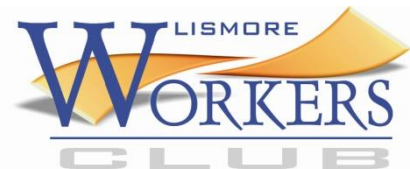

THERE WILL BE NO TROTTING THIS YEAR

SPECIAL REGULATIONS

1) HENDRA VIRUS VACCINATION: The North Coast National requires all horses attending the Lismore Show to be vaccinated against the Hendra virus. Only horses which have proof of vaccination will be allowed to enter the Showgrounds and compete at the events. Exhibitors will be required to provide the microchip number at the time of entry for each vaccinated horse. EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE: Horses must have received their second dose of the Hendra Virus Vaccination 21 days prior to the first day of their arrival onto the Showgrounds.

2) No person under disqualification recognised by this Association or the ASC may exhibit or compete.

3) Horses are to enter the Lismore Showgrounds via Dunoon Road gate only.

4) Horses will not be permitted on the grounds before Sunday 16th October.

5) Age of all horses to be calculated as at 1st August.

6) All horses competing on Saturday are to be shown in the Grand Parade or owners are liable to forfeit prize money - at the discretion of the Chief Ring Steward

7) The Society is not responsible for the non-delivery of Sponsor's trophies

8) No ribbon other than those awarded at the 2016 North Coast National Exhibition to be exhibited in the Grand Parade

9) Competitors age, as at the day of the event (See Showjumping regulation for Junior competitors)

10) Lismore Showground is outside the Cattle Tick Protected Area: Competitors from Qld are advised to contact their local Stock Inspector to clarify the current requirements needed to make the necessary arrangements for border crossings (bookings are essential) contact the Kirra Spray Facility (Tweed Heads) on ph: 07 5536 4714 or Aratula facility ph: 0427 133 388. Crossings are to be made in daylight hours. Qld exhibitors will need to make the necessary arrangements for their return entry into Qld at the border crossing on their forward journey. The cost of spraying etc, will be borne by the Exhibitor.

11) All special prizes are subject to Committee's approval

12) All exhibits must be presented in Show condition to the satisfaction of the stewards

13) All horses owners will be required to supply a PIC number for their property, or the property where their horse is kept

14) All horses must be registered with a recognised Stud Book of the breed and the exhibitor must be a current financial member of that Society. Horse registration papers must be presented to the Ring Steward for viewing before you can compete.

15) Random drug testing may be carried out at this Show

16) Any competitor found to have breached the ASC disputes and disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee.

17) For full Society Rules please contact the North Coast National A&I Society Inc

18) Should there be any reason to suspect that any Exhibit is either diseased or dangerous, or objectionable, the Society through its Officials, reserves the right of removing the same from or refusing it's admittance to the North Coast National Exhibition

19) The North Coast National A&I Society Inc shall not be responsible for any loss or damage caused (inter alia) through disease or infection howsoever arising.

20) No Entry is required for Champion prizes or consolation events

21) In all judging of Reserve Champions, the horse which gained second place to the horse awarded the Championship is eligible for Reserve Champion.

22) National Coast National Show District includes: Alstonville, Bangalow, Bonalbo, Casino, Grafton, Kyogle, Lismore, Mullumbimby, Murwillumbah, Nimbin, Maclean and Woodenbong.

23) Events will be carried out at the stipulated time, notwithstanding the absence of any exhibitor.

24) Where second prizes are offered and two exhibits compete, it is the Judge's discretion to award the second prize.

25) The committee has the right to alter the program or type of event if considered necessary.

26) The Senior Stewards in charge of judging rings are empowered with the approval of the Chief Ring Steward to exclude any competitor without explanation.

27) Tickets for entry to all events will be sold each day of the Exhibition from the Ring Control Office (not Show Secretary's office). No refunds and no competitor may enter an event without a ticket.

28) Prize Money: Horse events - Prize money must be collected on the day of the event and will be paid from the Ring Control office. Payment only issued on presentation of single voucher from ring stewards. Show Jumping paid at Secretary's Office up to 5pm each day with the exception of Saturday when prize money must be collected immediately after the last event.

29) Novice Hack - must not have won 1st Place in a like event at any Agricultural Show.

30) Intermediate Hack - must not have won an open first at a Royal or a champion at a HOTY show in an open hack event.

31) All competitors must be suitably attired for their events.

32) As requested by our insurer, all exhibitors must sign an indemnity/waiver or in the case of under 18yrs of age, a parent or guardian must sign prior to competing. All competitors must also complete a record of attendance form prior to competing. Upon signing an indemnity/waiver the competitor will be issued with a wristband which must be worn at all times. Competitors without a wristband will not be allowed into the ring to compete.

33) All Prize Money : 1st - \$10, 2nd - \$5 (Australian Stock Horse Classes also pay 3rd place - \$3)

34) Ribbons presented to 4th place

35) Headgear appropriate to the event in which you are competing must be worn.

36) Saturday - The winner of the Champion for individual rings is not eligible to compete in any further rings.

37) Show Hunters cannot compete in both Novice, Intermediate & Open Hack & Show Hunter Hack classes – you must choose. (Led Hack types may compete in the breed sections).

38) Post entries all classes except Champion of Champions

39) Entry fee is \$4 (incl GST) per entry unless otherwise stated

40) Access to the showground prior to Thursday morning is only available from 8am to 6pm. Officials will be at the gate to take entry fees to the show. Please note after these times gates will be locked. If only dropping off horses or gear gate fee will be charged & then refunded upon exiting within 30 minutes of entry – this applies to all days.

STABLING – All stables will be locked, stabling & camping MUST BE PRE-BOOKED & PAYMENT MUST BE RECEIVED at the North Coast National office 4pm Tuesday 18th October. Receipts will be issued & must be provided to the ring office to enable your stable to be unlocked. If you are sleeping on the grounds you must pay for camping.

a) In the event of any person placing horses in boxes or stalls or removing numbers without authority, the horse will at once be removed from the Showground by order of the Ring Committee.

b) No stall or box shall be used other than for the animal for which it has been allocated to, and in the event of a breach of this contract the Society may at any time re-allot the box to another competitor.

c) The allocation of stalls and feed rooms and the movement of horses and gear to and from such stalls and rooms shall be under control of the stable steward.

d) Exhibitors not following the instructions of the Stable Steward in relation to the above may be barred from competing and the animals concerned must be removed from the showground forthwith.

e) **A limited number of stalls are provided. Please complete the stall application form and return to the show office by the above date.** Yards available at no charge.

f) Horses will be measured at the Stewards discretion.

g) **Please apply for camping space when making stall application please refer to Stable Application in this booklet, payment must accompany booking.**

h) All bedding requirements to be supplied by exhibitor eg. sawdust. NO STRAW ALLOWED

i) All dogs brought onto the grounds must be under strict control and will be the responsibility of the owner.

j) Horses showing any type of tick will not be allowed onto the grounds, (including grass ticks) - see Regulation 10 above.

Stallion Safe Practise Regulations

i) Stallions cannot compete with Geldings or Mares in Hack or Riding Classes

ii) Stallions should wear official "discs" at all times whilst on the Lismore Showgrounds. These discs are to be worn on both sides of head collars and bridles or on same part of the horse on both sides to identify to others that the horse is a stallion

iii) No stallion is to be moved around the Lismore Showground without displaying the stallion discs and a suitable restraint. The restraint can be a bridle, a rearing bit or a chain lead rein over the nose or under the jaw.

iv) Where possible all stallions are to be stabled. If suitable stabling is not available stallions need to wear a collar, which is securely tied to the outside of a truck or trailer. Stallions tied to the outside of a truck or trailer MUST be supervised at all times.

v) Stallions may be substituted in prize-giving ceremonies with another horse should the rider deem it to be safer.

vi) Riders and handlers of stallions at shows be over the age of 17 years; however, it is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to understand the full code of conduct for stallions at events.

vii) It is the stallion owner's/rider's responsibility to ensure that all possible safety precautions are taken.

Floats/trucks that transport stallions should display the official magnet giving notice that there is a stallion on board.

Protests

A protest or complaint against any exhibit or exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the Ringmaster or Deputy Ringmaster no later than ten minutes after the judging of the exhibit or exhibitor. The Ringmaster or Chief Steward must be provided with the exact nature of the complaint and act, if necessary, to maintain competitive fairness. The Ringmaster or Chief Steward may choose to refer the matter to the Protests Committee, which shall comprise the President of the Society, or a Vice President and two other members of the General Committee. A protest or complaint or an appeal against the decision of the Ringmaster or Chief Steward may be lodged in writing with the Secretary no later than 10pm on the day of judging. Such protest, complaint or appeal shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which shall be forfeited if the protest, complaint or appeal proves to be frivolous or vexatious. A matter lodged this way shall be dealt with by the Protests Committee within 24 hours of lodgement and the decision of the Protest Committee shall be final. NB: No protest or complaint will be considered if it refers simply to a judge's decision.

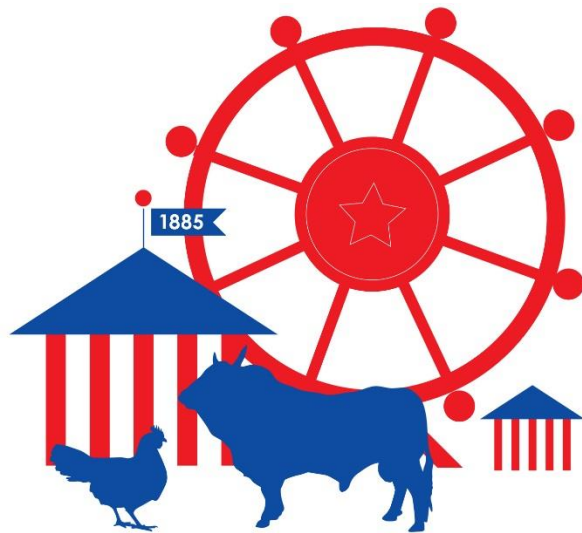
