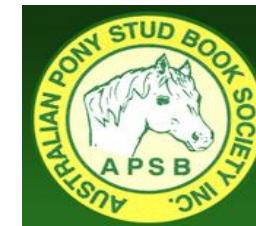

SPECIAL EVENT GUIDELINES

“Good Hands” - for riders 12 years & under 15 years on day of show. Judged solely on riding ability. Must use smooth single jointed snaffle bit, with or without cavesson noseband. Whips, spurs, straight bar snaffles and drop nosebands are not allowed.

Show Hunter Exhibits may not compete in the Open Ridden classes and vice-versa.

“Leading Rein Pony” – Pony 12hh or under, ridden by a child 5 years & under 8 yrs. Handler to be 18 years and over. Snaffle bit must be used. No spurs or whips. A leading rein is attached to the pony’s cavesson noseband, and is held by the handler in their left hand leaving the right hand free to help the child if needed. Pony will only be required to walk and trot individually on the circle, and walk and trot in the workout. It is the pony being judged, its conformation, paces & manners. It is not a smartest on parade.

"First-Ridden Pony" is one which is suitable as the first pony for a child once it is able to ride without a lead rein. Snaffle bit must be used. No spurs or whips. It must therefore still be a calm and very well mannered pony with enough good paces to encourage the rider. The height limit is 12.2hh and the riders must be 5 years & under 12 years old.

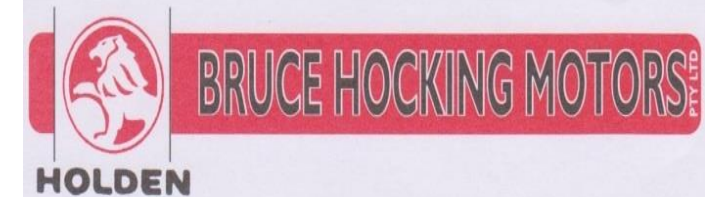

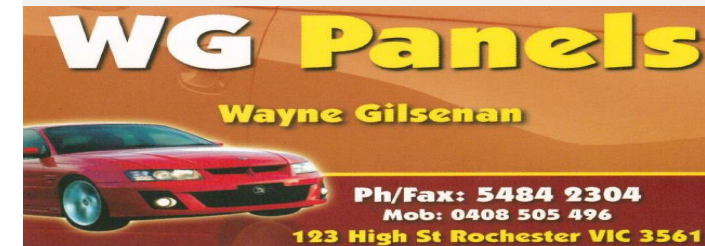
