

Conditions

- Please DO NOT PARK on the trotting track as it will be used during the day for the "Go to Town" trots event. Rings will be stopped while the "Go to Town" trots take place.
- Ring event tickets may be purchased from the Ring Office for \$2 each. Ticket required upon entry into ring.
- **Prizemoney** Ridden classes 1st \$3, 2nd \$2 and ribbons. Led classes receive ribbons only.
- Showjumping entries are taken at Ring Office, tickets not required, however wristbands are.
- The show will be run under ASC rules.
- **Drug testing may be carried out at this Show**. Any competitor, exhibitor, owner found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary Regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee and dealt with accordingly.
- Refusal of Entry/Alteration of Schedule: The committee reserves the right to refuse an entry without assigning any reason for doing so and to alter the schedule to meet emerging circumstances. This schedule may be subject to change if judges or sponsorships cannot be obtained
- Lunch breaks will be held at Judges discretion.
- INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Grenfell Show Society and waiving any claims against the Society for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. ALSO, on each Waiver, each horse with which the competitor is involved in competition at the Show must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.
- Wristbands will be issued to competitors upon completion of Indemnity Form. No wristband, no competing.
- Judge's Decision/Discretion the judge is empowered to withhold any or all prizes in any class where the exhibits are, in his/her opinion, unworthy of the prize, and at all times the judge's decision will be final. A judge has the discretion to ask that a led or performance exhibit and handler / rider / driver be ordered to leave the ring if he/she considers the animal is unruly and/or likely to cause an accident.
- District/Local Classes Horses and/or riders must have been resident of Weddin Shire for at least three months prior to the show.
- Novice Hack, Galloway, Pony A Novice has not won a First Place at any Show.
- Hack and Hunter classes Competitors must choose between Open classes and Hunter classes. They may not compete in both.
- Stallions Stallions must be wearing a bit at all times when being led and must be under the control of a person 17 years of age or older. They must be supervised at all times and securely fastened when tied to the outside of a truck or float. They are not eligible to compete in ridden classes unless their eligibility is specifically stated in the schedule with exception of Western Ring. No Stallions will be housed on Showground overnight.
- Ponies with Adult Rider Ponies may be ridden by adults unless otherwise stated in the schedule.
- Adult and Child classes Competitors must choose between adult and child hack classes. An exhibit may not compete in both.
- Lateness to the Ring Competitors must be ready when called. Once judging has commenced, a competing horse shall not be led, ridden or driven into or out of the judging ring without the permission of the judge and/or the Ringmaster or Chief Steward.
- **Horse Measuring** No official measuring will take place at the show, but, if a question about height arises, proof of height may be required. In the absence of proof, a decision will be at the absolute discretion of the Ring Master or Chief Steward.
- Breed Registration Registration documents for horses in breed classes must be produced when required by a Steward.
- Attire Competitors must be appropriately attired for the competition in which they are competing.
- Helmets Every rider is encouraged to wear a safety helmet compliant with the current Australian Standard. Riders under 18 years must wear such a helmet.
- **Footwear** All competitors must wear appropriate footwear when leading or riding a horse. When riding, the footwear must enable removal of the foot from the stirrup.
- **Cruelty** Persons who are considered by the Ringmaster or Chief Steward to be abusive or cruel to a horse will be expelled from the ground. No horse will be permitted to compete if, in the opinion of the Ringmaster or Chief Steward, it is in poor health or condition.
- Approaching Judges No exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a judge on judging day, before, during or after judging except through the Ringmaster or Chief Steward.
- **Prohibited Relationship** No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has or has recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the past twelve months.
- **Proper Conduct** Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively on the Showground will be expelled from the ground, may be banned from the show in future and may be banned by other Societies.
- Protests A protest or complaint against any exhibit or exhibitor may be lodged verbally with the Ringmaster or Chief Steward no later than ten minutes after the judging of the exhibit or exhibitor. The Ringmaster or Chief Steward must be provided with the exact nature of the complaint and act, if necessary, to maintain competitive fairness. The Ringmaster or Chief Steward may choose to refer the matter to the Protests Committee, which shall comprise the President of the Society, or a Vice President and two other members of the General Committee. A protest or complaint or an appeal against the decision of the Ringmaster or Chief Steward may be lodged in writing with the Secretary no later than 10 pm on the day of judging. Such protest, complaint or appeal shall be accompanied by a deposit of \$50 which shall be forfeited if the protest, complaint or appeal proves to be frivolous or vexatious. A matter lodged this way shall be dealt with by the Protests Committee within 24 hours of lodgement and the decision of the Protest Committee shall be final. NB: No protest or complaint will be considered if it refers simply to a judge's decision.
- Ringmasters decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into. We look forward to an enjoyable day of good horsemanship and sportsmanship. We hope you have a successful and enjoyable 2018 Grenfell Show



Show Jumping

Commences with course walk at 8.00am on Saturday, 1 September 2018. Entries taken at Ring Office from 7.30am, see below for entry fee relevant to class. Wristbands will be provided upon completion of Waiver Form. **No Wristband, No Competing**. No age limit to competitors unless stated, riders must be suitably attired and wear appropriate standard headwear. **All classes will run under EA rules**.

Class Five— this is a fun event. Riders are required to jump 6-8 numbered fences, dismount and get on a carriage and be driven through 6-8 numbered obstacles. The winner is the rider taking the shortest time to complete the whole course. Five seconds are added to the competitor's time for each jump dislodged, or obstacle disturbed during the drive stage. Being a timed event, riders achieving a double clear round will not necessarily be the winner.

Ellmore Driving Club will provide carriages and horse. Riders will draw for their order of attempting the course. They will then be advised of the carriage upon which they will travel for the drive part of the course.

There will be a full brief for riders, drivers and officials on the conduct of the event before the walking the course.

- The event is open to all thoroughbreds that have officially raced or trialled either locally, nationally or internationally. All horses are required to be 3 years and over and 14.2hh. All horses will be <u>registered with Racing Australia</u>.
 - *Registrations will be checked.
- 2. Racing name to be used.
- Qualifying Shows must be affiliated with Agricultural Societies Council of NSW Ltd or Show Horse Council of Australasia Inc.
- OTT Qualifying classes will be judged as a ridden class.
- 5. Once a qualifier has been won, the horse cannot compete in other qualifiers within the season. Horses that have achieved Runner Up are able to continue in the competition <u>unless</u> they win an OTT Qualifier class. The winner and runner up of each qualifying class will be eligible to compete in the State Final.
- Horses will be judged as a good example of a Thoroughbred rather than riding horse/hunter types with the following being taken into consideration.
 - Thoroughbred qualities
 - Conformation
 - · Manners, paces and performance
 - Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
- Judges decision is final in qualifiers and final.
- Horse and Owner must reside in ACT or NSW to compete in the Off the Track ACT/NSW Series.
