# HORSE COMPETITORS - PLEASE NOTE

## INDEMNITY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED AND WRIST BANDS MUST BE WORN

- **Drug testing may be carried out at this show.**
- **All PIC numbers must be entered on wavier. NO PIC NO ENTRY.**
- **Please check website prior to show for any Judge changes.**
- All competitors must be responsible for the health and well-being of their own horses.
- Any Champion Show Hunters or Champion Hacks from rings 2, 3, or 4 may not compete in the same classes in another ring.
- Any horses competing in hack classes **MUST NOT** compete in show hunter classes and vice versa.
- All horse events are post entry, meaning entry on the day of show.  
Tickets will be available from the horse tent, next to the entry to the main area. Show Jumping entries will be taken at the float next to the Show Jumping course. **INDEMNITY FORMS MUST BE SIGNED AND WRIST BANDS MUST BE WORN**
- An entry ticket must be presented to the ring steward for competitors to gain entry to the ring. Due to safety concerns, competitors **ONLY** to enter the ring. For juniors **ONE** adult supervisor per competitor may enter. **NO EXTRA EQUIPMENT**, including prams, chairs, umbrellas etc. to be taken into the ring
- There will be **NO** refund on unused tickets
- All exhibits in breed classes must be registered with their relevant breed societies and competitors **MUST** be financial members.
- Registration papers must be produced on request.
- Stallion handlers/riders must be 18yrs and over and only compete in specified classes.
- Horse age to be calculated from August 1.
- **The judges and stewards decision will be final.**
- Ribbons will be awarded to third place.
- No prizemoney will be awarded for classes, unless otherwise stipulated. Champion and Reserve Champions will receive \$20 and \$10 respectively. Supreme Champions will receive a ribbon, unless otherwise stated.
- All drivers and passengers must pay the advertised gate price. Please note: membership of the Finley Show Society Inc. entitles free entry to the show. For further information contact the show secretary.
- **STABLING:** Due to a limited number of stables, bookings will not be accepted without payment. All competitors must supply their own bedding, feed bins and water buckets. **ALL STABLE BOOKINGS AND ENQUIRIES TO BREANNE 0418 674 892**
- **NO TAPE YARDS:** electrified or not.
- **CAMPING** is permitted at a fee. **POWER WILL NOT BE AVAILABLE.**
- **VETERINARY SURGEONS:** Contact details will be available from the Shows Secretary's Office. Services rendered by any veterinary surgeons to animals at the Show will be the owner's expense.
- Disputes must be referred to the ringmaster who will adjudicate if necessary with the help of the disputes committee, appointed prior to the commencement of the show. All disputes **MUST** be lodged within one hour of the event in question. They must be in writing and include a fee of \$50 which will be forfeited if the dispute is not settled in favour of the competitor who raises the dispute.
- **NOVICE:** Open to all horses who have not won a first place at an agricultural show.
- **INTERMEDIATE:** Open to all horses who have not placed 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 3<sup>rd</sup> in a hack class at a royal show
- **LOCAL CLASSES:** Horse and rider must reside within 25km of Finley showground.
- **RINGS WILL NOT BE HELD UP.**

# VAS OFF THE TRACK RIDDEN

- 1. Open to any thoroughbred horse bred to race that has been stud book registered, either domestically with the Australian Stud Book or Internationally that are 4 years and over and over 14.2 hands.** Registrations will be checked by VAS office.
- Racing name to be used where appropriate. When entering if name is different to racing name, please provide the following details (if known)
  - Racing name
  - Microchip number
  - Life Number
  - Registration Certificate Number
  - Dam and Sire
  - Date horse retired
- Riders to be 14 years and over on day of qualifying Show.
- Qualifying Shows must be VAS Ltd affiliated.
- Qualifying classes will be judged ridden.
- Once a qualifier has won, the horse cannot compete at another Show qualifier in that calendar year.
- All qualifying winners gain automatic entry into the Racing Victoria Off the Track Series Final to be held at the VAS Ltd Saddle Horse Championships.
- To be judged as a good example of an Off the Track Thoroughbred, (rather than riding horse/hunter types), with the following being taken into consideration:
  - Thoroughbred qualities
  - Conformation
  - Manners, paces and performance
  - Injuries caused through racing such as blemishes are allowed
- Judge's decision is Final in Qualifiers and Final.
- Qualifier Prizes: Sash, \$50 Prize Cheque sent out once qualification has been verified by Racing Victoria (Gift pack collected at State Final).

## **REGULATIONS:**

1. Pony Club rules regarding uniform and equipment will apply, however, to assist riders competing in other rings, a white shirt and tie will be accepted, without penalty.

4. One horse/one rider Rule applies. However, a rider may ride more than one qualified horse, but the rider must nominate only one horse for the Allan Gardiner Memorial point score, prior to the start of the show.
5. The age of the riders is the actual age on the day of the show.
6. Medical arm bands MUST be worn with updated information included.
7. Only ordinary snaffle bits may be used.
8. Pony Club Membership Cards, showing attendance, for the preceding 12 months, must be available to view, if required. The horse and rider, as a combination, must have attended two club rallies, in the preceding 12 months and that the rider is eligible to represent their Club (rally attendance).
9. Pony Club ring will NOT wait for the other rings to finish and those participating in the 'Champion' event, for each section, must stay in the general area, ready to commence promptly.
10. Tickets for this ring must be purchased at the ticket tent prior and be presented to the steward at the beginning of each event.

**HIGH POINT COMPETITION:** Allan Gardiner Memorial Ribbons will be awarded to the 'Pony Club All Rounder', both Senior (13-26yrs) and junior (under 13yrs), awarded on a point score (4-3-2-1) for all eligible Pony Club events.
