**The Committee reserves the right to refuse or cancel any entry without giving reason for so doing**

The East Coast Arabian Championships are conducted under the rules of the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Limited (AHSA), together with the rules and definitions printed in this Schedule. Copies of the current AHSA Rule Book are available from the AHSA website. Closing date of entries is Friday 26th February, 2021. Entries can only be made via [www.nominate.com.au](http://www.nominate.com.au)

COVID 19 RESTRICTIONS WILL APPLY AT SIEC

- NSW Health regulations apply, you may respectfully be asked to leave SIEC if you do not comply, including following all hygiene and physical distancing guidelines. Should this occur to a competitor, entry fees will not be refunded.

**LATE ENTRIES AT THE SHOW WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED, however a horse that is previously entered can add additional classes at the show, at twice the entry fee price. Classes with NIL entries at time of close of entries will NOT appear on the timetable, or in the catalogue and will not be catered for. These NIL entry classes cannot be entered once entries have closed. No late requests for stabling or camping can be made, unless a horse requires accommodation for finals nights**

**THERE WILL BE NO REFUNDS OF ENTRIES** after the closing date; Unless the public health orders force the cancellation of this event. Entries will be refunded in full, less the 5.5% Nominate online entry charge.

Reduced entry fees: Reduced entry fees will apply to Financial Members of the NSW Arabian Horse Association Inc. only (not the Arabian Horse Society of Australia Ltd). If you are not a financial member of the Association, you can join or renew each year from the 1<sup>st</sup> July. Please note that our membership year runs from 1<sup>st</sup> July to 30<sup>th</sup> June . If you wish to join at this time of year, please login to the "CLUBS" section at [www.nominate.com.au](http://www.nominate.com.au) BEFORE doing your entries.

Stabling: The cost of stabling will be as follows (Excludes GST) Stable Fee \$35.00 per day (or part thereof); Bedding: Shavings \$15.00 per small bag. Stable Bond: \$82.50 per stable payable on each stable, which is refundable when the stable is inspected, found to be completely empty and a "Passed Stable Bond" slip is provided to the committee. Stabling days are worked out as starting from 6am. Small Bags of shavings purchased at the show will be charged at \$25.00 per bag

Day Parking Fee: There is a day parking fee for those competitors working out of their floats at a cost of \$10.00 per horse per day (plus GST). Day parking will be in the North Truck area, and toilets are available in this area. Camping: There are 2 types of accommodation available at Horsley Park:- Powered Camp Sites (for tents, caravans, floats or trucks – supplied by the exhibitor) at \$35.00 per night (Plus \$150 bond) or the Demountable Cabins at \$60.00 per night (Plus \$150 bond). Bookings must be made on entries and accompanied by full payment. No phone bookings will be taken. All accommodation bonds will be returned if cabin and campsites are left in a clean and tidy, or if no extra power leads were plugged in at campsites. Please realise only one power cord per campsite. Extra power cords plugged in will be noted by our stable/camping warden and SIEC and bonds will not be returned; and extra charges will be applied..

Pending Registrations: All horses entered MUST be registered with the Arabian Horse Society of Australia with correct registration numbers available at the closing date of entries. All horses entered without registration numbers MUST provide these registration numbers prior to the printing of the catalogue. Failure to comply will make the horse ineligible to compete. Pending registrations at the close of cataloguing will NOT be accepted and no refund of entries will be given for such horses.

Timetable of Events: The Timetable will be available for downloading from the Association website ([www.nswarabian.org.au](http://www.nswarabian.org.au)) approximately 2 weeks prior to the commencement of the show. The starting times in the timetable are final and will only be changed if a ring is running late. No class will start ahead of the advised time. EVERY EFFORT WILL BE MADE TO RUN THE CLASSES AS ADVISED IN THE SCHEDULE. IN THE EVENT OF ENTRIES EXCEEDING PREVIOUS YEAR'S NUMBERS, SOME EVENTS MAY NEED TO BE MOVED TO ANOTHER DAY TO ACCOMMODATE NUMBER OF ENTRIES. YOU WILL BE NOTIFIED IF THIS IS THE CASE.

Show Office: Opening times: Thursday 4pm to 7pm. Fri/Sat 7am to 5pm. Sunday 7am to 4 pm

Exhibit Numbers: Numbers to be collected from the show office during the hours listed above. EXHIBITORS NOT WEARING THE CORRECT EXHIBIT NUMBER AS PER THE CATALOGUE WILL NOT BE JUDGED.

Committee Accepts No Responsibility: It is the owner's responsibility to protect property as the Committee shall not be liable to any person in case of loss or damage by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect, however arising.

Awards: All Classes will be awarded Champion, Res. Champion and 3 x Top 5 equal placings, unless otherwise stated. Dividing or Combining of Classes: Should entries warrant, classes may be divided according to height, gender or date of birth, at the committee's discretion. At the closing date of entries should numbers in classes be insufficient, classes may be combined at the committee's discretion. In the case of a Performance Class no more than 12 horses will be on the circle at any one time.

Purebred Halter : Will be judged on Saturday evening, with live scoring being provided by Horse\_Mark.

Exhibitors Please Note: No exhibitors will be permitted to enter the ring once the Marshall has closed the ring (handed the ring card over to the steward).

**FUTURE FARMS 3YO CHALLENGE**- This class is for horses that turn 3 years of age on August 1<sup>st</sup> 2020. These classes are open to registered Purebred Arabians and Derivative Breeds ONLY. MUST BE RIDDEN IN A SNAFFLE BIT. The horses will be judged as both led and saddle horses, and the 2 scores combined to give an overall winner. Open to both purebreds and derivatives registered with the AHSA. Handler/Rider must be the same for each led and ridden section. Maximum of 3 horse/rider combinations, however all horses must have a suitably attired handler/rider at all times. Winner will receive a garland and a kersey rug, runner up to receive a cotton rug all kindly donated by FUTURE FARMS.

Young Horse Saddle Classes are open to horses 3 & 4 years of age ONLY and must be ridden in a snaffle bit. These classes are open to registered Purebred Arabians and Derivative Breeds ONLY. 4 year old horses entered in this class are NOT eligible for entry into the East Coast Cups. Maximum of 3 horse/rider combinations, however all horses must have a suitably attired and capable rider at all times. No horses are to be presented before the judge unmounted.

Open Saddle Horse Championships are classes for horses 3 years & over as at 1<sup>st</sup> August 2020.

East Coast Cup Saddle Awards are for horses 4 years and over as at 1<sup>st</sup> August 2020. These classes are open to registered Purebred Arabians and Derivative Breeds ONLY. Horses are to be presented and ridden as Open Hacks ie. English riding attire, including gloves, Weymouth Bridles (no Pelham or rugby Pelham bits), plaits (no running plaits) and English Saddle essential. Hacking canes and spurs optional, no dressage whips permitted. HORSES ARE TO BE JUDGED AS OPEN HACKS. Please note, horses entered in the Young Horse Saddle Classes are ineligible to compete in this event. Maximum of 3 horse/rider combinations, however all horses must have a suitably attired and capable rider at all times. No horses are to be presented before the judge unmounted.

**SHIRANNA SASH SENIOR RIDDEN** – Ridden classes to be judged by a National AHSA Panel Judge. For Arabian Derivatives who carry a minimum of 50% Arabian blood as stated on the AHSA Stud Book. Over the age of 4 years. A garland sponsored by Shiranna Garlands for the winner with sashes provided to 6<sup>th</sup> place by the NSW AHA.

NEWCOMER classes are open to horses from 3yrs of age that have not previously been shown/or competed on under saddle prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January 2021; however due to the loss of the 2020 show year, we will have Newcomer 2020 classes also. These horses must be ridden in a snaffle. This includes Dressage, Adult Riding Club and Pony club competitions.

Classic/Best Head & Trot Classes: Winners of Classic/Best Head & Trot classes are not eligible for their respective age Championships.

Colts/Stallions: No Colt or Stallion is permitted to be handled/ridden/driven by persons under 18 years of age.

Swabbing: Random Swabbing of any exhibit competing at the show may be required at the discretion of the Committee or the presiding judge. It is a condition of entry of the show that permission be given by the registered owner for all or any exhibits entered to be swabbed by a qualified veterinarian should the Committee or presiding judge so request.

Conduct of Exhibitors: No exhibitor may leave the judging area until directed by the ring stewards. Use of noise making devices, in the marshalling area are not permitted. Excessive use of whips will not be tolerated. Lunging of horses in the marshalling area or on entry into the ring is not permitted. Any person found setting off fire alarm or tampering with fire hoses/hydrants will be liable for a fine of \$1,000.00.

No smoking within the fenced Stable compound. NO BIKES,SCOOTERS OR WHEELED vehicles are allowed in the stable compound area. Those competitors with mobility scooters need to contact SIEC for an authorisation pass. Prams and strollers must be kept a safe distance from all horses.

Code of Behaviour Card System A card system will be used at this year's show to deter types of behaviour (Reportable Conduct) wherever occurring on the grounds and at any times during the show including events. As per the Arabian Horse Society of Australia rule book. Outside of an event at the Committee's discretion.

**Any competitor whose conduct is considered to be ill mannered , aggressive or unsportsmanlike will be issued a warning and may be asked to leave the ring. Further displays of this behaviour (including breaches of the AHSA Social Media policy) will result in a cancellation of membership and a ban on competing at New South Wales Arabian Horse Association events for up to 5 years.**

Photographer Our invited and official photographer is Foxwood photography.

Use of Buggies at SIEC Anyone driving golf carts or buggies during the show at SIEC, must sign a waiver with SIEC Management staff and be issued a wristband BEFORE they can drive such vehicles. All drivers must be licensed drivers and adhere to public road rules where applicable. No golf cart and/or buggy can be driven after dusk. No intoxicated persons can drive golf carts and/or buggies. As the roads through SIEC are public roads, the Police will be randomly patrolling these roads during our event. Only the stable warden buggy will be allowed access to the stable area.

Dressage Horses or ponies may not be ridden by more than one rider. You can enter as many tests as you wish. Test levels must be consecutive. Horses with 60 or more grading points cannot compete at a lower level. Sashes to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

BODY GREASE – Any horse/s that appears to have any form of body grease substance applied to their coat, face makeup excluded, will be prohibited from exhibiting in any classes at this Show.

SIEC DOG POLICY – dogs must be on leads at all times. Dogs are not to be left unattended. Barking/nuisance/ dangerous dogs will be asked to leave.

Hot weather policy: In the event of extreme hot temperatures, please refer to the EA website for guidelines.

NON PRO CLASSES

The NON PRO rule applies to persons of any age. A NON PRO is a person who regardless of his/her equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, in the last 3 years has not accepted any remuneration (money) for services usually provided by a professional in the areas of breaking, riding, training, schooling, driving, halter preparation, showing in halter or under saddle. Any competitor that receives financial remuneration (money) for showing another person's horse within 3 years prior to the event would not be eligible for NON PRO classes. NON PRO CLASSES – As from January 1<sup>st</sup> 2015 Amateur Classes have been changed to Non Pro. You will have to fill out the Non Pro form attached to the Entry forms. (in accordance with the AHSA ruling)

PRIZEMONEY- Prizemoney Cheques will be made payable to the registered owner of the winning exhibit. All prizemoney will be paid at the show.

FIRST RIDDEN CLASSES IN THE YOUTH RING:

These are normally for small ponies up to 12.2h and for riders 5 years and under 12 years; however being an Arabian show we have opened these classes up to ponies, galloways and hacks (split into these heights), and riders from 5yrs to 17 years. Horses must be ridden in a snaffle bit, and are judged on suitability as an "off the lead" mount. Cavesson nosebands only, a narrow strap or "monkey grip" is allowed to be attached to the front of the saddle. Cane not to exceed 40 cm and no spurs permitted. No Cantering is allowed on the ring, however a short canter is allowed during the workout. These horses must possess excellent manners and provide their youth riders with an experience that instils confidence.

Rugs are awarded for all dressage test winners, liberty class winners, major derivative halter classes, major derivative saddle classes, major purebred saddle classes. Classes, Supremes or Grand Champions marked with an \* will be presented with a rug.

A voucher will be handed out to the competitors. If your class is lucky enough to be sponsored, then you will receive an embroidered rug. Sponsorship for these embroidered rugs is \$150 per class. Be quick to pay and secure sponsorship for your favourite class.

LIBERTY CLASSES(As per the Arabian horse Society of Australia rule book)

- a) Guidelines for Judging - The purpose of this event is to see the Arabian horse in all its glory. The emphasis is on movement, especially at the trot, as the Judge considers the overall balance and proportion of the exhibit, tail carriage and length of stride. At the Trot we are looking for a free swinging movement with forelegs extended well forward from the shoulder, the feet dwelling for a moment at full stretch before contacting the ground, exhibiting the characteristic floating action. There should be a matching free forward swing of the limbs from the shoulders and the stifles, with the knees and hocks being well flexed and hind legs brought well forward under the body. A display of other paces is acceptable.
- b) Time - It is recommended that the Judging time for this event be two (2) minutes, with one (1) minute catching time. A suitable and safe catching area must be provided.
- c) Rules:
- i) Horses must be 2yrs and over
  - ii) The use of whips and shakers should be in moderation.
  - iii) No more than 3 handlers be present in the arena at one time.
  - iv) A safe and suitably sized Arena with particular attention being given to the fencing shall be used.
  - v) The work area is to be marked into 3 zones or for arenas smaller than 20m x 40m- 2 zones – one at each end max 1/4 of arena (Middle area 2/4) or in the case of a smaller arena a zone at one end of the arena.
  - vi) One handler only per area at all times during the 2 min performance.
  - vii) Handlers must 16yr & over or 18yr & over if showing a stallion or colt.
  - viii) Audience participation is encouraged in the way of clapping and cheering however the use of other aids such as shakers, bins etc is not encouraged. This should be clearly conveyed to the audience prior and if necessary during the event by the announcer and if necessary the Ring Master.
  - ix) The performance can be halted at any time as the well being of the horse is of paramount importance and horses should not show any sign of stress
  - x) Event organisers MUST have a competent Ring Master that will be responsible for the running of the class.
  - xi) If the horse becomes stressed and continually runs to the gate it is the responsibility of the Ring Master to having the music stopped and horse caught. In this case there will be a NO SCORE.
  - xii) The announcer/music controller to work closely with the Ring Master so music can be stopped at any time as instructed by the Ring

FREESTYLE RIDDEN CLASSES .Judge:

Sashes to 10<sup>th</sup> place. (Donated by NSW AHA)

Workout to be in harmony with the chosen music. Walk, trot, lengthen trot, canter (both left and right) and a clear halt in front of the judge all need to be shown. Open to purebred Arabians, Derivative Breeds and API index horses.

Competitors may choose from Dressage, Hack, Western, Stockhorse, Side saddle or Fancy Dress Attire. This attire needs to be appropriate to the style of riding chosen.

Workouts will be judged as follows:

- 1.Presentation
- 2.Quality of walk
3. Quality of Trot
4. Quality of lengthen trot
5. Quality of canter on the right rein
6. Quality of canter on the left rein
7. Quality of halt in front of judge
8. Composition and flow of workout

9. Suitability of Dress to workout
10. Suitability of workout to Music
11. Overall impression and harmony of combination

\*Workout will be a maximum of 3 mins. This class will be timetabled. Need to show 3 clear paces. Music to be on USB or CD and CLEARLY LABELLED with your name, horses name and your time. This class will NOT be judged as a hack class. To be handed in on Friday 19th March before 10am to the Secretary.

HIGHPOINT YOUTH AWARDS: Will be presented at the beginning of Saturday Finals night. Points will be awarded on a one horse/one rider combination; however a youth competitor may choose to have more than 1 horse/rider combination in contention. Age group winners will be notified quickly after the completion of the youth events. Each age group Highpoint winner must present mounted, where an overall Highpoint Youth award will be presented. Rugs will be awarded for each age group Highpoint winner. Only youth events on the Saturday count towards this Highpoint.
