The ASC has introduced new procedures for recording of Horse Results which all societies need to follow. The procedures have been put in place for The Show – Newcastle & Hunter Horse Competitions. Given restrictions in place under the NSW State Government Public Health Order, the Newcastle AH&I strongly advises that **all entries are finalised by 5pm Friday**, **19**th **February 2021**

NEW Horse Competition ENTRY PROCESS

- All competitors must complete a WAIVER found on our website (www.Newcastleshow.com.au/horses)
- ENTER ONLINE All entries are now online Please visit www.Newcastleshow.com.au/horses. Alternatively, you can come into the Show office and enter/pay in person
- EARLY ENTRY FEE: \$10 per entry
- ENTRIES TAKEN ON THE DAY: \$20 PER CLASS
- One Entry Form will need to be fully completed for each horse or if entering Riding Classes, for each rider. You can enter multiple classes online.
- Vehicle Entry Fee: For 2021 Show, vehicles entering the Showground must pay a gate entry fee of \$15 per car. Parking space for horse floats will be provided to the driver of the vehicle at no additional charge on payment of gate entry. Please note: Entry benefits are available to Members of the Association. The \$15 vehicle entry is valid for one (1) competitor and one (1) other person. Additional passengers must pay the standard entry prices.
- An Exhibitor Number will be created for each entry. These will be available at the Horse Office on the day of your competition. If you would like these posted to you prior to the Show, please email admin@newcastleshow.com.au
- Show Jumping Entries via Global OnLine <u>www.globalentriesonline.com</u> **No entries will be accepted on the day of competition.**
- To gain Entry to the Ring, each competitor MUST show to the steward their Exhibitor Number and Ring Ticket. Without the Ticket and the number, the competitor will **NOT** be allowed to compete.
- All entries **MUST** hand in an Animal Handling Risk Acknowledgement Waiver before competing. PIC Numbers must also be registered with the Horse Office before competing under recommendations by the ASC and State regulatory bodies.

Schedules do change every year: therefore, it is important that you read the Schedule thoroughly – including the conditions or regulations, making note of the relevant information, for example: NB:

- Due to safety concerns, **Competitors ONLY to enter Ring**. For Juniors ONE adult supervisor per competitor may enter. NO extra equipment including prams, chairs, umbrellas, etc. is to be taken into the Ring.
- **Drug Testing** may be carried out at this Show. Any competitor found to have breached the ASC Disputes and Disciplinary regulations will be investigated by the ASC Disciplinary Committee. This policy can be found at <u>www.agshowsnsw.org.au</u>.

JUDGING

All decisions of the Judge/s will be final.

All exhibitors are requested to refrain from conversing with the Judge/s during judging unless asked to do so.

GATE ENTRY:

Griffiths Road Gate only. All competitors must complete a Waiver Form which are found on our website, and post completed forms to the Horse Section, PO Box 53, Broadmeadow NSW 2292 or email to admin@newcastleshow.com.au, by the closing date, Friday 19th February 2021 at 5.00pm. All Horse entries are now online, please visit www.newcastleshow.com.au/horses to enter online.

ENTRY TO THE GROUNDS:

 For 2021 Show, a gate entry charge of \$15 per car must be paid. Parking space for Horse Floats will be provided to the driver of the vehicle at no additional charge on payment of gate entry. Please note: Entry benefits are available to Members of the Association. See page 2 note for further information. PLEASE NOTE THE \$15 ENTRY IS ONLY VALID FOR COMPETITORS AND 1 OTHER PERSON. ADDITIONAL PASSENGERS MUST PAY THE STANDARD ENTRY PRICES.

HORSE FLOATS & TRUCKS:

 PLEASE BE AWARE THAT LIMITED PARKING and STABLING IS AVAILABLE INSIDE THE SHOWGROUND. Access to this area is via the Griffiths Road Gate - for this Show, horse float parking is available on a 'first come first served basis'. However, it is recommended to book stables.

STABLING & FEES:

- A Stable Application form for booking stables is set out in on our website. Please book your Stable when entering the Horse competition through the online portal. Application must be lodged and paid online by Friday 19th February 2021 at 5.00 pm. If you do not want to pay online, please come into the Show office and pay in person.
- All Stable Fees must be paid prior to the event.
- All competitors to supply own bedding, feed bins and water buckets.

PLEASE NOTE: STABLES WILL BE RE-ALLOCATED IF NOT ATTENDED BY 9 AM ON THE DAY OF BOOKING. COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REFUSE ANY APPLICATION.

COMPETITOR ENTRY FEES:

- All events \$10 per class pre-entry by 19th February, entries taken on the day will be \$20 per class. (There will only be a small number of entries taken on the day)
- One Entry Form will need to be fully completed for each Horse/Rider per event. No refund will be given if the entrant does not compete.

The Committee may consider a refund if a Vet/Medical Certificate is provided. The Committee reserves the right to refuse a refund.

PRIZE MONEY:

No prize money for classes. Champion and Reserve Champions will receive \$10 and \$5 respectively. Supreme Champions will receive a ribbon, unless
otherwise stated.

HORSE AGE:

• To be calculated from 1st August 2020.

ENTRY TO THE RING:

- To gain entry to the ring, each competitor MUST show to the steward their Exhibitor Number and Ring Ticket. Without these numbers the competitor will NOT be allowed to compete.
- Due to safety concerns, Competitors ONLY to enter Ring. For Juniors ONE adult supervisor per competitor may enter. NO extra equipment, including
 prams, chairs, umbrellas, etc, is to be taken in the Ring.

STALLIONS & COLTS:

Must be led by a bar, chain or bit when required and may only compete in those classes as set out for stallions and colts. Handlers must be 17 years and
over.

ATTENTION:

- All competitors in breed classes must be registered with their Association and MUST be current financial members if not, disqualification will occur.
- Registration papers must be available on request. If insufficient entries, classes may be combined.
- Every exhibitor bringing horses to the Show will be required to list each horse being shown, together with the PIC for the property from which it has come on the Waiver Form before competing.

DRESS:

All competitors must be suitably attired (including slacks, shirt, tie, boots, etc.) and must conduct themselves in an orderly manner at all times.

IMPROPER BEHAVIOUR:

Outside assistance to competitors by word, by radio or any other method in Horse Ring Events will not be permitted. If in breach of this ruling, competitors and their exhibits may be dismissed from the event and from the Showground. Competitors names to be submitted to the A.S.C.

DISPUTES:

• All disputes to be referred to the Horse Committee who will adjudicate the dispute. All disputes must be lodged within 1 hour of the event in question in writing together with a fee of \$50 which will be forfeited if the dispute is not settled in favour of the competitor who raises the dispute.

JUDGES:

The Committee reserves the right to substitute a Judge if deemed necessary and to delete or combine any class as required.

VETERINARY SURGEONS:

Will be available during the Show. Services rendered by the Veterinary Surgeons to animals at the Show will be at owner's expense.

DEFINITIONS:

- 1. LOCAL CLASSES: Restricted to residents of Newcastle City, Lake Macquarie and Port Stephens Shire.
- 2. MAIDEN: Is a hack which has not been placed in any individual ridden hack class at any Official Show.
- 3. **NOVICE:** Is a hack which has not been placed 1st in any individual ridden hack class at any Official Show.
- 4. ELEMENTARY: One which has not won more than three first prizes in an individual class at any Royal Show.
- INTERMEDIATE: Is one which has never been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any individual ridden hack class at any Royal Show including the R.N.A.
 NEWCOMER HACK: is one that has not been shown or competed under saddle (Racing excepted) prior to the 1st January in its first year of being shown
- 6. NEWCOMER HACK: is one that has not been shown or competed under saddle (Racing excepted) prior to the 1st January in its first year of being shown or competing. Once shown under saddle, such horses cease to be a Newcomer on 31st December that same year. All horses in Newcomer Classes must be shown in a Snaffle Bit.
- 7. SUPREME HACK: Consists of Champion Ponies, Galloways, Hacks and Supreme Show Hunter.
- THE CHAMPION will be selected from the 1st place winners from each of the eligible classes. Under no circumstances shall a Judge award equal Champions.
- 9. THE RESERVE CHAMPION will be selected from the remaining 1st place winners and the 2nd place getter from the class which supplied the Champion.
- SUPREME CHAMPION will be according to the Schedule.
 A JUDGE officiating at an Official Show is under no obligation to award any placing if he/she considered such placing not up to standard.
- 12. SHOW HUNTERS cannot compete in Open Rings 1 & 2.
- 13. OPEN HACKS cannot compete in Show Hunter Classes Ring 3.
