Public Liability: It is mandatory for all competitors to be covered by Public Liability. If you are not a current member with insurance of The Arabian Horse Society, Hunter Valley Arabians Inc. any other Affiliate, or another equine association with 24/7 Public Liability Insurance, you will be required to tender \$12.00 per person and complete the Registered Participant Application for each person who will be riding and/or handling your horse at this event. Membership numbers will be required

Definitions & Conditions of Entry

- **We will NOT be providing any programs, please bring your own Program.**
- **Remember, to ensure your health and safety and that of others, if you have symptoms consistent with coronavirus (fever, cough, sore throat, or breathing difficulties) please stay at home**
- All competition at this show is governed by these regulations and by the Arabian Horse Society of Australia for Discipline in Horse Sections at Shows. Should it become necessary for the Disciplinary Committee to open an inquiry into any aspect of competition in this Horse Section, this Society will support any penalty imposed by that Committee as a result of the inquiry and will support penalties resulting from enquiries arising from Horse Sections at other NSW show.
- **INDEMNITY AND WAIVER FORMS:** The Horse Committee will take all care in managing the Section, but competitors taking part in this Horse Section do so at their own risk. Each adult competitor must, before competing, complete and sign a form indemnifying the Arabian Horse Society of Australia and waiving any claims against the Society or association for any injury sustained in competition or for loss or damage to the competitor's property or damage caused by the competitor or his/her animal(s) at the Show. A similar form must also be completed and signed by a parent or guardian for each competitor who is under 18 years of age. ALSO, on each Waiver, each horse with which the competitor is involved in competition at the Show must be listed together with the Property Identification Code (PIC) of the property from which the horse came to the Show.
- **There will be no refunds of entries.**
- Entry in this Show is voluntary, by entry; all Exhibitors & Competitors agree to be bound by and will be run under the current Arabian Horse Society of Australia and Department of Primary Industries guidelines.
- Horses competing in Breed classes, Handler & horse must be registered with the relevant Breed Societies and must produce registration papers and current membership cards on demand.
- **No Dogs Allowed on the grounds. No Strollers, Prams, or bikes to be on the arena at any time.**
- Only officials and judges are permitted in the Judge's tents/Horse floats on the arena.
- **Committee Accepts no Responsibility:** It is the policy of the Committee to see that all due care is taken to protect property, but the Committee shall not be liable to any person in case of loss or damage by reason of any defect, accident, negligence, or neglect, however arising.
- The Committee takes no responsibility for the safety of animals or for the safety of animals left unsupervised.
- Committee & Officials will not be held responsible for any accident or damage caused by or to any Exhibitor or Exhibit. All Competitors compete entirely at their own risk. All spectators attend the Show entirely at their own risk.
- The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entrant; without assigning a reason, no claim shall be made against the Association should entry be refused.
- A Show Official, the Ringmaster and or Judge may request any unruly horse such as a bolter, bad behaviour or a danger to the rider/handler or other competitors/spectators to be removed from the ring and or grounds. The competition should not continue until the horse is removed as requested.
- Any Competitor not suitably attired may be precluded from competition. It is the responsibility of **all Riders** of horses on the grounds during the Show to wear approved Safety Helmets & suitable Riding Boots.
- All accidents, injury or damage of any kind must be reported by those concerned to a Show Official on the day of the Show and any such incident shall be duly recorded.
- The Committee and Show Officials do not take any responsibility whatsoever in respect to any non-reported matter/s of accident, injury or damage occurring at the Show.
- The Show Committee reserve the right to interpret all questions or incidents regarding or arising from this Show without recourse. Their decision will be final.
- Protest must be delivered in writing to the secretary, no later than one hour after the class in question. A \$50 fee must accompany the protest and will be forfeited if the protest is not upheld by the ground jury.
- The Show Committee may change any Judge without notice.
- The Judge's decision is final. If a judge considers an exhibit does not possess sufficient merit to deserve a prize, the prize shall not be awarded. Horses which, in the opinion of the judge, exhibit unsoundness will not be awarded a prize. The Judge's decision is final.
- **Rings will not be held up for class clashes without the approval of the Ring officials,** advice of any clashes must be made to Ring Officials prior to the commencement of the conflicting classes.
- No stallion or Colt is to be handled / ridden by a person under 18 years.
- Horses that compete in the Show Hunter Ring are ineligible to compete in the Open Hack Ring and vice versa.
- **NOVICE** is any Horse or Rider that has not won in any similar event at any Agricultural Show or recognised Show.
- **INTERMEDIATE** is any Horse or Rider that has not been placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd in a similar event at any Royal Show or Exhibition
- **NEWCOMER** is any horse that has not been shown or competed other than racing prior to the 1st of January
- **DPI Regulations** are in force at this show and will apply to everyone and you are confirming that to the best of your knowledge your exhibit is/are in healthy condition.
- Ponies not exceeding 14hh, Galloways over 14hh not exceeding 15hh, Hacks over 15hh. Horses age to be calculated as of the 1st of August.

- Current Measuring Certificates will be accepted & are to be produced on request. Any Horse not having a current recognized Certificate may be required to be measured.
- Classes maybe split if numbers warrant at the discretion of the committee.
- If a ring finishes early the committee has the right to transfer classes to that ring.
- DPI Regulations are in force at this show and will apply to everyone. PIC numbers to be supplied for all horses at this Show; and you are confirming that to the best of your knowledge your exhibit is/are in healthy condition.
- No competitor will present for judging before a judge with whom he/she has a family relationship, has, or has recently had a personal relationship or has had horse related business dealings during the past twelve months. Coaching: Any person detected coaching a competitor while that competitor is being judged may be removed from the Showground. Proper Conduct: Any exhibitor or associate who behaves offensively on the Showground will be expelled from the ground, may be banned from the show in future and may be banned by other Societies.
- **Random drug testing may be carried out at this Event.**
- Drug testing may be carried out, any competitor found to have breached the ASC disputes & disciplinary regulation will be investigated by the ASC disciplinary committee.” Approaching Judges: No exhibitor or associate will initiate conversation with a judge on judging day, before, during or after judging except through the Ringmaster or Chief Steward. Prohibited Relationship Sponsorship opportunities are available for our next show. Please contact the committee for details.
- **Trade Stands** are welcome, please contact the committee prior to the show.
- **Youth Classes - Handlers:** All handlers must be 5 years and over on the first day of the show. Handlers under 7 must be accompanied by an adult. Handlers must be 7 years or over on the first day of the show to compete independently. Handlers 7 & 8 years may be accompanied by an adult.
- **-Riders:** All Riders must be 5 years or over on the first day of the show to compete independently. Riders in Leading Rein classes must be 3 years or over on the first day of the show.
- **Youth Handler - Eligibility,** A youth is defined as any person of minimum age 5 years, and under the age of eighteen 18 years at the first day of the show who, in the opinion of the parents / guardian can safely lead and control (i.e. handle) a pony or 22 horse. Where numbers permit the competition could be divided into age groups. The winner of each age group may then compete for a special award called Champion or Most Competent Handler.
- **-Assistance:** Youth Handlers under seven (7) years of age **MUST** be accompanied by a parent / guardian / competent adult in the ring. Handlers 7 and 8 years **MAY** be accompanied by a parent / guardian / competent adult in the ring. However, if necessity calls for the accompanying adult to interfere with, or take over the horse, the Handler may be penalised. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to ensure that a suitable horse is used in these classes.
- **-Safety:** If, in the opinion of a steward or official, the horse is unsuitable from a safety perspective, the parent\guardian may be asked to remove the horse from the ring. There shall be no appeal against this decision. •Horses must be led on the near side, disabled competitors may request a variation of this rule. •No lead is to be wrapped around the leader's hand, but the loose part folded in a figure of eight in the hand. •All turns are to be made to the right.
- **We will NOT change the program BUT** if you require a Breed class that is **NOT** on the program, if you turn up on the day a class will be added in for both Led & ridden. There will be no Champion or Reserve ribbons awarded. You will be able to compete in your respective Supreme class

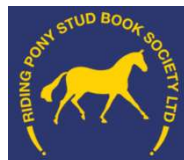

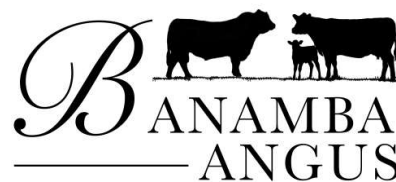
